CAMPING RULES

- 1. **REGISTRATION**: Registration forms are mailed out by the APMA Office beginning in January.
- 2. **RESERVATIONS**: Reservations can be made in person or by phone. Payment is required to reserve a RV site. You can request a specific site, but no guarantee it will be available. Once payment is received your site will be assigned and a confirmation sent to you.
- 3. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY**: Full refund if cancelled one (1) month before the reserved date. 50% refund if cancelled two (2) weeks before. No refunds after two (2) weeks before reserved date. ** IF UNABLE TO ATTEND AFTER MAKING RESERVATIONS PLEASE LET THE OFFICE KNOW SO WE CAN REASSIGN THE SITE TO PEOPLE ON OUR WAITING LIST.
- 4. **SLIDE OUTS**: Slide outs must be within your assigned space. Please be considerate of your camping neighbor.
- 5. **TROLLEY TRACKS**: All vehicles and trailers must remain 15 feet away from the trolley tracks (this includes any drop-down ramps). **NOTE: The 15 feet space must remain empty at all times.** This is for your safety.
- 6. AIR CONDITIONING: *No air conditioning allowed unless operated by a generator.*
- 7. **QUIET TIME**: For everyone to enjoy their stay, quiet time is from **10 pm** to **6 am**. Please respect your fellow campers. *No generators during quiet time*.
- 8. **VEHICLES**: Please observe the **5-mph** speed limit. Only one recreational unit is allowed per camp site. Vehicles must be properly parked in such a way that the traffic lanes are not blocked.
- 9. NON-LICENSED VEHICLES: Registration of all non-licensed vehicles (age 14+ drivers only) must be completed before being operated on the grounds during any event. This includes, but is not limited to: golf carts, ATV's, gators, mopeds, pocket motorcycles, scooters, etc. (Handicap mobility vehicles are excluded from this requirement.) Must also observe the 5-mph speed limit, be in control at all times and be careful of pedestrians and vehicles.
- BICYCLE RIDING: Only vintage/antique bicycles, 50 years or older, (including unicycles and tandems) will be allowed on the show grounds during show hours (7am 6pm). All other bicycles are prohibited during show hours on the Show Grounds and in all campground areas. (Dry Camping area west of the trolley tracks excluded.) Must also observe the 5-mph speed limit.
- 11. **DUMPING:** No gray or black water on ground. Gray water disposal in identified receptacles only.
- 12. **GARBAGE**: Please put all garbage in marked trash dumpsters and **ONLY broken-down** cardboard in the cardboard dumpster.
- 13. CAMPFIRES/FIREWORKS: No campfires or fireworks allowed. Gas grills okay.
- 14. ALCOHOL: No alcohol on the show grounds.
- 15. **SMOKING**: No smoking allowed in or within 10' of any building or grandstands.
- 16. **PETS**: We welcome you and your pets and wish to remind you that you are responsible and accountable for them and their actions. For the safety of all, they must be on a **6-foot locked leash** and cleaned up after.
- 17. EXITING: No vehicle exiting show grounds from 1pm 3:30pm during the Steam-Up parade.
